The seven permanent galleries consist of "Circulation of Carbon", "Low Carbon City", "Global Warming", "Low Carbon Science & Technology", "Low Carbon Life", "Low Carbon Future" and "Kids' World". LCSTM also has two special-effect theaters, Dome Theater and Giant Screen Theater. By offering more than 100 interesting and interactive exhibits such as "The Formation and Existence of Carbon" and "Global Warming", the Museum is dedicated to promoting science spirits, methodologies, thoughts and popularizing science knowledge.

LCSTM will enhance international exchanges and cooperation, building itself as a center for low carbon science popularization, green architecture display, low carbon academic communication and information distribution.
