




Results: Environmental Learning

Publications and public relations:

- Brochure of the project for spring and for autumn
- Active internal and external communications
- Environmental awareness book publication to all schools and preschools in Espoo
- Environmental awareness publication to 4000 marathon runners in the city of Espoo
- Several campaigns with posters.
 Posters distributed citywide.
- Environmental awareness video planned, implemented and published citywide





Results: Environmental Action

Participation:

- Over 10 000 citizens have taken part in events, courses, nature school, exhibitions etc. including schools, individual people and families, work places, organizations and universities
- Over 200 bags of garbage cleaned from the beaches by over 600 people
- Hundreds promises made by individual citizens to change their behavior to more environmentally friendly
- Created cross-administrative network and collaboration with local universities, schools and NGOs
