GREEN Olympiad - 2019

'Green Olympiad', initiated in 1999, is India's greatest and premier bi-lingual Olympiad conducted by The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) with an aim to gauge the knowledge of students on issues related to environment. The growth of the Olympiad in terms of its extent and numbers is an indication of its success. The examination reaches out to over 2000+ schools annually. Initially the Olympiad was for students of class 8-10, but the examination is now conducted at 3 levels, and opens for students from classes/grade 4-10.

'Green Olympiad' is not just restricted to India, but has gone international with participation of schools from Nepal, Singapore, Kenya Indonesia, Iran, Bhutan, Sultanate of Oman, United Arab Emirates, Kuwait, Qatar, Kingdom of Bahrain, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Russia, Fiji, Bahamas, and Mexico D.F. An indication of the quality of the Olympiad can be gauged from the fact that it is endorsed by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO) New Delhi since 2011. The program has also been supported by the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEF&CC), Central Board of Secondary Education, SCERT Goa, Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, Navodaya Vidyalaya Samiti, Army Educational Welfare Society, etc. over the years.

'Green Olympiad' is a bilingual written examination comprising objective questions that tests the student's knowledge, analytical skills, and simultaneously spreads awareness on environment issues through informative questions in a booklet that can be retained by students after the examination. There are no negative markings, and students can answer from the comfort of their school as each school is a centre for its registered participants. The ultimate goal is to create an environment conscious informed national and international school network.
