Youth	Youth need tangable project to work on as inter-RCE activity	Work with next year's local host, RCE Grand Rapids, and UNU-IAS to develop a virtual conference series on sustainable development in region of next year's meeting; see if local host can host youth represenatives to come and work on an SD project in the region that the local host recommends (over 18 for liability issues?); then have youth work on project one week before regional meeting and present it during the meeting itself	TBD
