On top of that, as environmental destruction problems such as domination of fast fashion and resource depletion become serious, as the value of co-prosperity of mankind and the issue of coexistence with the next generation are added, the term ‘sustainable fashion’ has emerged.

Sustainable fashion needs to ponder on sustainability in all aspects of the life cycle of the fashion product as a fashion item that is manufactured, sold and used in a sustainable manner in terms of raw material production, manufacturing, transportation, storage, marketing, final sale, use, reuse, repair, and recycling. In addition, from a socio-economic point of view, companies fulfilling their ethical responsibilities by improving working conditions at factories and sales sites or returning profits to society can also be included in the category of sustainable fashion. In this regard, we plan to hold the ‘DEOS 2022 (2022 Dobong ESD Open Seminar)’ under the theme of ‘**Our Wardrobe for Sustainable Fashion**’ in connection with the theme of ‘sustainable fashion’ in Project Neuru season 2 this year. Through the voices of students participating in Project Neuru season 2 and the lectures of overseas speakers who strive for sustainable fashion, we would like to consider how we should practice and act for ‘our wardrobe for sustainable fashion’.
