1. Case study presentation

Case study presentations will take place during the meeting (IN THE MORNING SESSIONS – please refer to the tentative schedule) and each speaker will be allotted 15 minutes for presentation followed by 5 minutes Q & A (if time permits). Speakers will be asked to prepare their presentations, once the RCE project is accepted.

The overall theme will be *“Youth Engagement – Empowering our Youth to be Change Makers”*

**Please note that applications for the case study presentations are only open to RCE members in the Americas region.*

2. Application for case study presentation

We request that applicants keep their inputs to the RCE Project portal as concise and clear as possible. This information will be the basis for evaluating the suitability of your project for a presentation at the Regional Meeting. Kindly note that your RCE Project will be published on the RCE Portal upon submission.

3. Criteria for selecting presenters

- Address how your project is contributing to the implementation of SDGs through education.
- Demonstrate engagement of multiple stakeholders, including participation and support of local communities
- Demonstrate contribution to the theme “Youth Engagement – Empowering our Youth to be Change Makers”
- Analyse and demonstrate impacts in terms of how projects have brought positive changes to the communities
- Discuss ways of further scaling up, mainstreaming and deepening ideas and actions of the project (ways forward)
- Scale up ESD and sustainable development activities in the region with reference to UNESCO’s Global Action Programme and the SDGs.

4. Selection result

The selection result will be notified in early September 2023 via email to the applicants.
